Humble Service as Described by The Apostle Paul

It is hard to overestimate the impact of consistent and excellent leadership over the years. During my second year at Saint Luke's, we interviewed one candidate to be director of the preschool. The country was still recovering from the housing bubble that had burst, and enrollment in our preschool was about 80. Financially we were on tenuous ground, and friction between the preschool and the church had caused a rift between the congregation and its best outreach ministry.

Michele Hart, with a degree in Early Childhood Development from Virginia Tech, was not only our single applicant for the job, but also singularly gifted in her abilities to fulfill it. I could not have known 10 years ago, not only what a decade of excellent leadership would mean a decade later to our award-winning preschool (with 113 students and a waiting list), but also how wonderfully Michele would fulfill the job description written by the Apostle Paul in Romans 12:

Prophetic in seeing challenges before they happened, humble in serving the children with the greatest respect; teaching not only the children but also the staff; encouraging in the face of great obstacles -- even to keeping the preschool open during a pandemic; giving of herself, her time and her love, leading diligently and placing the preschool on a solid financial and administrative foundation which it previously lacked; showing mercy, whether it's tending boo-boos with ice packs or helping to raise food, money and an appreciation of sharing our blessings, both near and far.

On Sunday, April 30th, we had a rare chance to thank Michele for her service to children in the name of Jesus Christ at St. Luke's, and just as importantly, to thank God for sending her to us at just the right time.


