Rev. Dr. Hyo Lee, District Superintendent will be our special guest preacher for the 60th Anniversary on September 10, 2023

Dr. Lee was born in South Korea in 1964 and raised in a Christian home through the faith of his mother and grandmother. After graduating from Yonsei University, one of the schools established by Presbyterian and Methodist missionaries in 1885, he served three years in the Army as an officer. In 1990, he came to the States to further his theological education. He completed his M.Div. from McCormick Theological Seminary, and Ph.D., from Vanderbilt University Graduate School. He was ordained

in the Tennessee Annual Conference as an elder in 1999 and transferred to the Virginia Conference in 2000. He previously served churches in Arlington, Danville, Winchester, and Alexandria districts. While serving a local church in Winchester, he also taught biblical studies at Shenandoah University. He has served on the District Committee of Ordained Ministries, Conference Board of Ordained Ministries, CEMCA, and Asian American Ministers' Associations. Rev. Lee and his wife, Kay, who is a registered nurse, have two children, Joshua and Sophia, living in the Washington D.C. area.

Anniversary Gifts Invited

Once more we are celebrating a milestone at St. Luke's United Methodist Church. For sixty years St. Luke's has been a vibrant part of the community, worshipping God, ministering to the spiritual needs of members and strangers, while reaching out in mission through such programs as CARITAS, CCHASM, Vacation Bible School, food, and school supply drives, and witnessing to God's Word. For those still hesitant to get out after our experience of "shut-down," we have online worship weekly and the United Women of Faith are pioneering "Zoomba" small groups over the internet.
